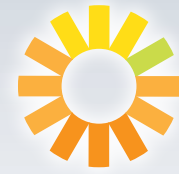

What is the Business Energy Tune-Up Program?

The Business Energy Tune-Up Program is a NO COST energy analysis program for businesses who are Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E) customers in Fresno, Tulare, or Kings counties. The program is sponsored by The City of Fresno and PG&E and is designed to help businesses save money & energy.

What is a Benchmark?

Energy benchmarks are energy comparisons between buildings of similar size, occupancy type, and location that can help save building owners/operators money by providing them with information on how energy usage is distributed within their building.

What are 4 reasons I should participate in the program?

1. Energy use may be your single largest operating expense and this program will provide you with an unbiased report identifying energy- & cost-saving opportunities.
2. Chances are, your energy bill is higher than it should/could be.
3. Energy efficiency upgrades represent a potential goldmine of untapped savings.
4. Energy efficiency upgrades also free up cash flow that can be used to fund additional efficiency investments or simply be moved to another part of the business.

What will I get from the program?

A NO COST benchmarking energy-use analysis report, which includes:

- Energy performance versus similar facilities
- Energy conservation recommendations designed to save money and energy
- Details of your current energy consumption and identification of energy inefficiencies
- Information on available PG&E programs, incentives, and financing options that can save additional money
